“Beekeeper versus Bee”

Celia Davis started beekeeping in 1980 and ran 14 stocks for many years. She has now reduced her operation to five colonies. She taught and lectured in pure and applied biology for a number of years and has been closely involved with beekeeping education since the early 1990s, serving for six years on the BBKA Examinations Board and continuing to act as a tutor for the Correspondence Course, and an examiner at all levels. She has produced two books and lectures to groups throughout the UK.

Gerry started beekeeping at school in 1958, passing the BBKA Preliminary (now called the Basic) a year later. He is a Master Beekeeper, Senior honey judge and gained the National Diploma in Beekeeping in 1986. He has served at local, county and national level including 18 years as BBKA correspondence course organiser and 19 years on the BBKA examinations



board. Currently President of Doncaster BKA & BBKA Examiner.

Graduating in Zoology in 1968 he has spent most of his working life lecturing in Biology at Doncaster College, retiring in 2007 to spend more time with his 25 colonies to enable him to build up an extensive collection of photographs which are used to illustrate his articles in the *BBKA News* and his presentations.

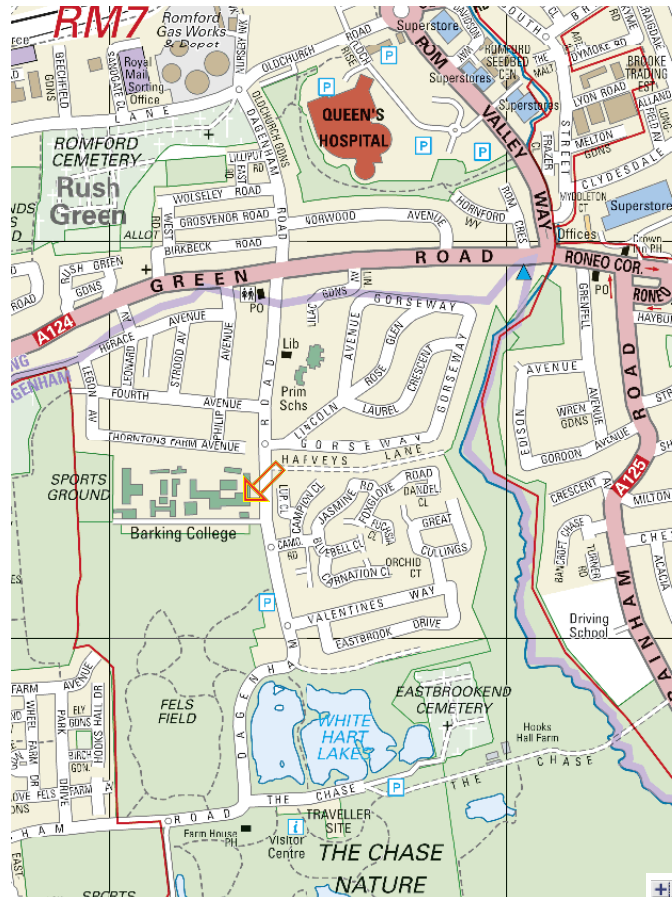
